### **Ofsted**

### **Senior Leadership Team**

### **Communication**

If the Teacher in Charge feels that the issue requires the input from the SENCo or myself, Mr. King or Mr. Rhodes then they will inform us and we will ensure that we make contact with you in a timely manner.

Of course, if you have an urgent issue that you feel needs to come straight to the Senior Leadership Team, then please contact the office at your school and they will pass on your message.
